

Predatory Journals

Predatory journals, also known as fraudulent, deceptive, or pseudo-journals, present themselves as legitimate academic publications but engage in misleading practices. Typical predatory behaviors include falsely asserting that they offer peer review, concealing details about Article Processing Charges (APCs), misrepresenting their editorial board members, and committing various breaches of copyright and scholarly ethics.
