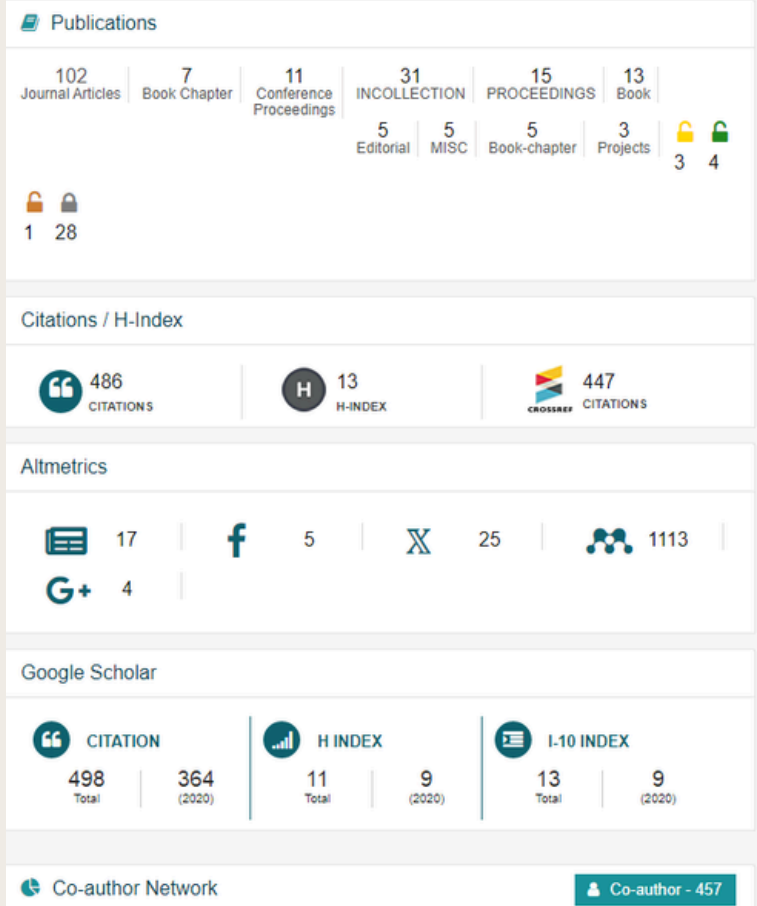

Author of the Month

Swami Vivekananda Literature

Swami Vivekananda (1863–1902) was a prominent Indian spiritual leader, philosopher, and social reformer. Born as Narendranath Datta in Kolkata, he was deeply influenced by his guru, Ramakrishna Paramahansa, who shaped his spiritual outlook. Swami Vivekananda introduced Indian philosophies of Vedanta and Yoga to the Western world through his iconic speech at the 1893 Parliament of the World's Religions in Chicago, where he began with the famous address, "Sisters and Brothers of America."

He founded the Ramakrishna Mission in 1897 to promote education, social service, and spiritual enlightenment. Known for his message of universal brotherhood and selfless service, Vivekananda emphasized the importance of youth empowerment and interfaith harmony. His teachings continue to inspire millions worldwide. National Youth Day in India, observed on January 12, commemorates his birth anniversary.

One Nation One Subscription (ONOS) is an ambitious initiative by the Government of India aimed at improving access to scholarly resources for the academic and research community. It seeks to ensure that high-quality journals, databases, and other academic resources are universally available to all educational and research institutions across the country.

Key Objectives of ONOS:

- Universal Access: Provide equitable access to scholarly content for all institutions.
- Cost-Effectiveness: Negotiate centralized subscriptions to reduce duplication and lower costs.
- Research Boost: Enhance the quality of research by providing resources to even the remotest institutions.
- National Collaboration: Promote knowledge sharing and collaboration among Indian researchers.

This initiative is expected to democratize access to knowledge, accelerate innovation, and strengthen India's position in global research.
