


Online Access to Print Journals



Dr. Satishkumar D. Tala

PUBLICATIONS, CITATIONS / H-INDEX, GOOGLE SCHOLAR

Dr. Satishkumar D. Tala is an Associate Professor in the Department of Chemical Sciences at Atmiya University, Rajkot. His research focuses on Synthetic Organic Chemistry, Heterocyclic Chemistry, Medicinal Chemistry, and Anticancer Research. He designs and synthesizes novel organic molecules, particularly heterocyclic compounds with pharmaceutical and material science applications. His work in Medicinal Chemistry involves developing bioactive molecules for potential cancer treatments. Dr. Tala has published 84 journal articles, 9 books, 4 conference proceedings, and 1 patent, earning 431 citations with an h-index of 11. His research bridges chemical synthesis with practical medical applications.

Author of the Month Kundanika Kapadiya

Kundanika Kapadia (1927–2020) was a Gujarati writer, feminist, and social thinker from India. She is best known for her novel Sat Pagla Akashma (Seven Steps in the Sky), which explores women's liberation and self-identity. Her works often focused on gender equality, personal freedom, and social reform.

Kapadia wrote novels, short stories, and essays, influencing feminist thought in Gujarat. She was also associated with the Nari Granth Prakashan movement, which aimed to promote women's literature. Her contributions to Gujarati literature earned her respect as a progressive voice advocating women's empowerment.

This initiative is expected to democratize access to knowledge, accelerate innovation, and strengthen India's position in global research.
