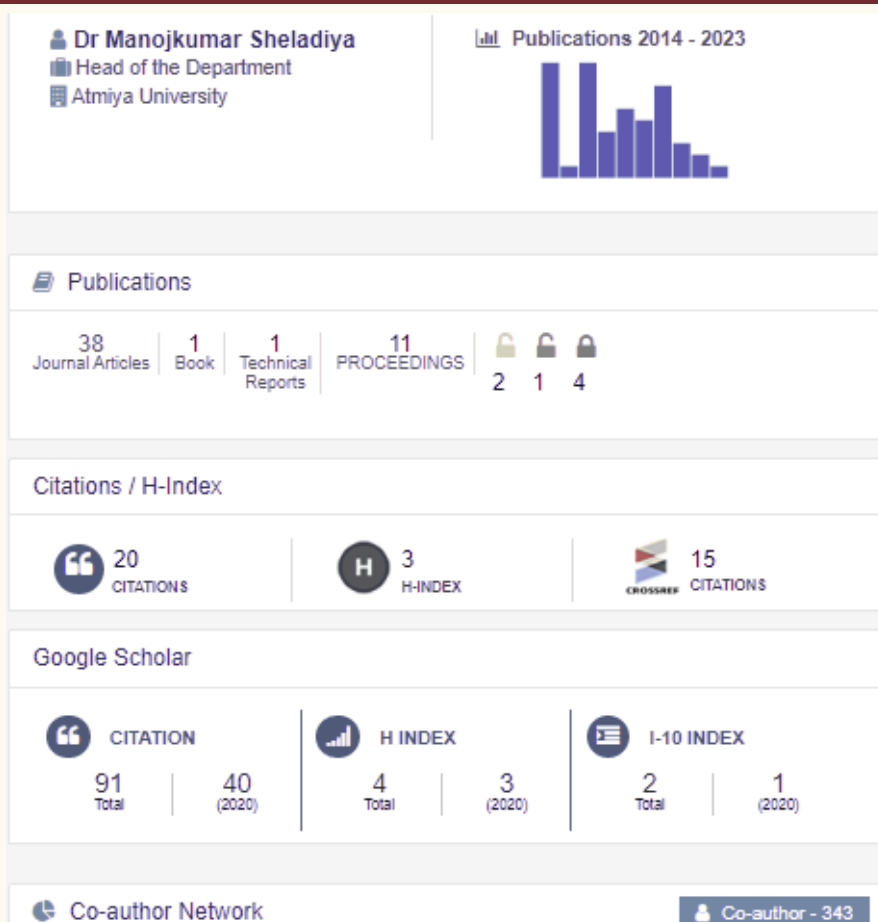

Dr. Manojkumar Sheladiya is the **Head of the Department** of Mechanical Engineering at Atmiya University, Yogidham Gurukul, Rajkot. He earned his **Ph.D. in Mechanical Engineering** from Gujarat Technological University in 2023, along with an M.Tech (2013) and B.E. (2008). With expertise in **casting, thermal engineering, fluid mechanics, and sustainability**, Dr. Sheladiya has led the department since 2013. He has published **38 research works** (including journal articles, a book, technical reports, and conference proceedings), earning **20 citations** and an **h-index of 3**. He holds life memberships with reputable professional bodies such as the **Institute of Corrosion (UK)**, **Indian Society for Non-Destructive Testing**, **International Association of Engineers**, and the **Indian Society for Technical Education**.

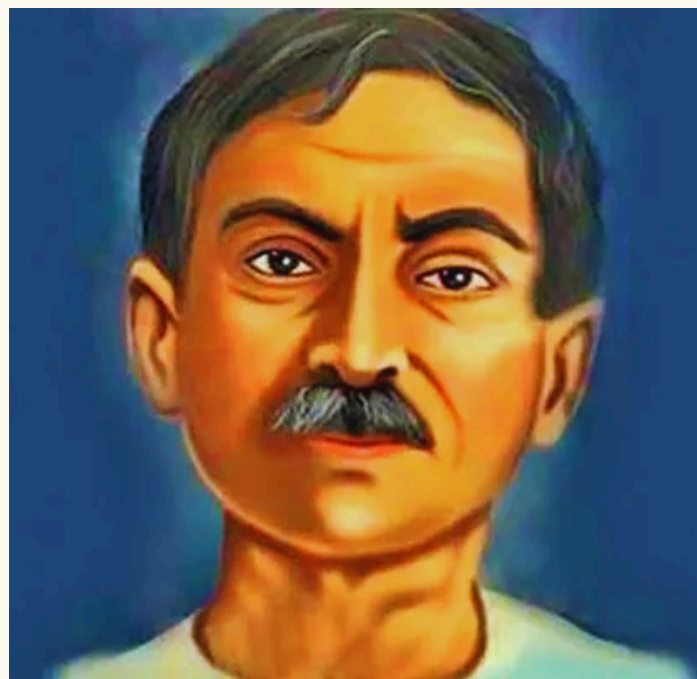

Author of the Month

Munshi Premchand

Munshi Premchand (1880–1936), born as Dhanpat Rai Srivastava, was a legendary Indian novelist, short story writer, and social reformer. He is regarded as the father of modern Hindi and Urdu literature.

He was born on 31 July 1880 in Lamhi, a village near Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh. Facing hardship from a young age after losing both parents early, he turned to books and became a teacher. He started writing in Urdu under the pen name Nawab Rai, later adopting the name Premchand.

Premchand's works reflect rural life, poverty, social injustice, women's struggles, and freedom movements. His famous novels include *Godaan*, *Gaban*, *Nirmala*, and *Sevasadan*. His short stories like *Kafan*, *Idgah*, and *Shatranj ke Khiladi* are considered literary gems.

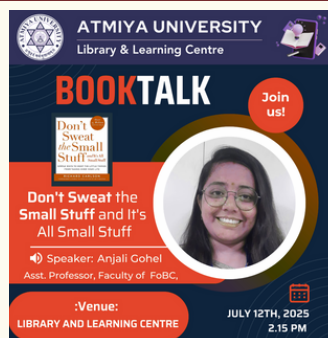
Library Activity in July

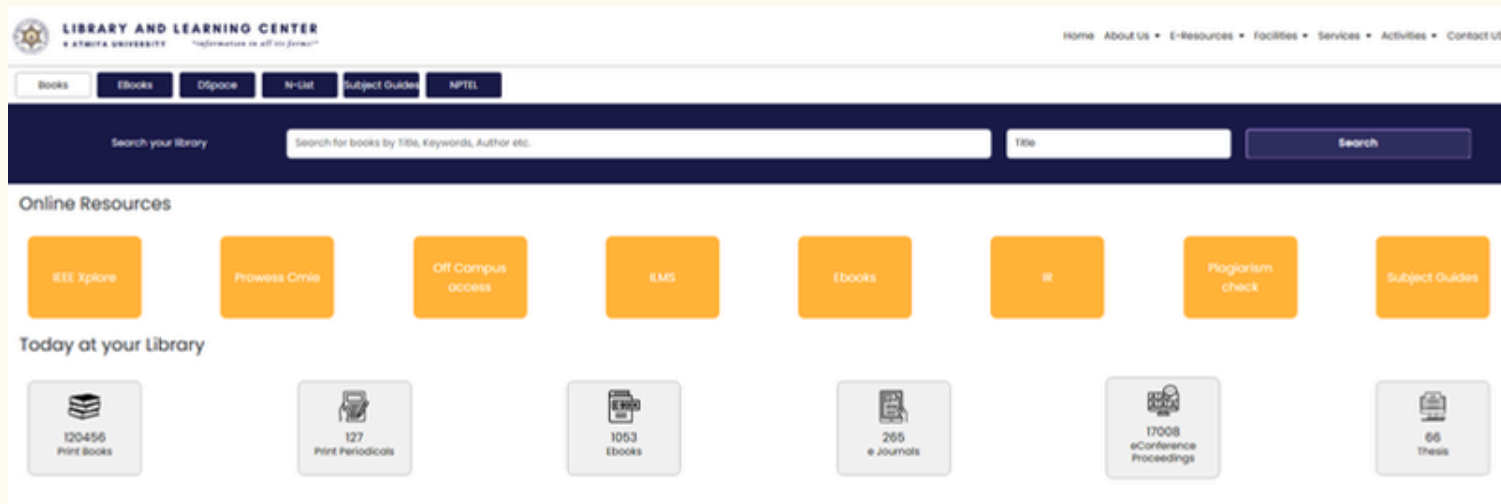
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
