Dr. Bhargav N. Waghela Assistant Professor, Department of Life Sciences, Atmiya University

Academic Qualification & Experience: Holds M.Sc. and Ph.D. degrees, with over 11 years of teaching and research experience in biological sciences.

Areas of Expertise: Molecular Biology, Genetics, Cellular Signaling, Cancer Biology, Endocytosis pathways, and host-pathogen interaction mechanisms.

Research Contributions: Published multiple research articles in reputed journals covering topics such as **hereditary breast and ovarian cancer variants, signaling in health and disease, drug resistance mechanisms in cancer cells, and molecular insights into NADPH oxidases.**

Recent work includes **virtual screening of phytoconstituents from Acorus calamus L. as inhibitors of Monkeypox virus infection (2025)**, published in the Journal of Genetic Engineering and Biotechnology.

Academic Engagements & Activities: Participated as a faculty resource person in academic workshops and training programs related to protein biology and biotechnology techniques.

Author of the Month

Vaju Kotak

Vaju Kotak was a distinguished Gujarati writer, journalist, publisher, and film personality who made a lasting contribution to Gujarati literature and journalism. Born on **30 January 1915 in Rajkot, Gujarat**, his full name was **Vajubhai Kotak**. He studied up to the first year of B.A. and later chose journalism as his lifelong profession.

In **1937**, he moved to Ahmedabad and from **1939** settled in Bombay (now Mumbai), where his career gained momentum. His greatest achievement was the founding of the Gujarati weekly magazine **Chitralekha** in **1950**, which became highly popular and played a major role in shaping modern Gujarati journalism. He also launched other publications such as **Bij, Light**, and the film magazine **Jee Cinema**.

Along with journalism, Vaju Kotak wrote novels, essays, and columns noted for their simplicity and social awareness. He also worked in Gujarati and Hindi films as a screenwriter and assistant director. He married **Madhuriben** in 1946 and passed away on **29 November 1959**, leaving behind a rich legacy in Gujarati media.
