Open access is a global movement advocating free online access to academic content. It removes financial, legal, and technical barriers, allowing unrestricted reading, downloading, copying, and distribution. This model contrasts with traditional subscriptions, enhancing research visibility and accessibility. The Berlin Declaration (2003) outlines open access principles, embraced by numerous academic institutions worldwide. Publication avenues include:

- 1. Full Open Access Journals: Published on platforms, often requiring Article Processing Charges (APCs).
- 2. Hybrid Journals: Subscription-based journals allowing APCs for open access articles.
- 3. Green Route: Depositing publications in trusted repositories.
- 4. Diamond Route: Publishing in journals/platforms without APCs, typically funded by institutions.

Peter Suber, an open access pioneer, provided this definition.
